Early Childhood Education

They will develop child-centered curricula, use innovative teaching methods like experiential learning, and foster active parental involvement in education. Emphasis is placed on respecting each child's individuality, collaborating with educational professionals, and promoting inclusive, tolerant environments. Graduates will also engage in lifelong learning, reflect on their professional practices, and uphold ethical and democratic values.

Pedagogy of Primary Education

This study program prepares graduates to work as primary teachers or specialists in general education schools, equipping them to create inclusive, innovative, and engaging learning

The program emphasizes using modern technologies, ICT, and assessment methods to enhance education quality and foster virtual learning spaces. Strong communication and collaboration skills are developed for working with families, colleagues, and multicultural communities. Humanistic and democratic values are instilled alongside practical skills for pre-primary education, ensuring graduates can support young children's self-expression and competencies. Lastly, the program fosters reflection, goal-setting, and continuous professional growth for lifelong career development.

Social work

Lithuanian Sign Language Interpreting

They will master expressive and grammatically accurate sign language, recognize different sign language types, and effectively communicate ideas. Additionally, they will gain knowledge of the deaf community's culture, the impact of hearing impairment, and relevant technologies. Emphasis is placed on adhering to professional ethics and supporting inclusivity in diverse settings.


